Although the official start of the campaign is later in the fall, we encourage every family to participate in this collection beginning NOW. So far, only 212 out of 500 registered families have participated this year.

The Archdiocese in turn, can continue its important work on priorities such as Home Mission, Catechetical Programs, Lay Formation, support of seminarians, social justice initiatives, just to name a few. All parishioners play an important role in the success of this important annual endeavor. We are grateful for your support and your involvement. Our parish Appeal goal is set this year for \$49,262.00 (based on the amount of offertory collections for 2022 and the number of registered families). If we fall short of this goal again, the deficit has to be paid from our regular operating cost bank account.

Traditionally the minimum donation for Sharing God's Gifts campaign is \$300.00. (\$25.00 per month)

You can start or continue your consistent monthly use of the Sharing God's Gifts envelopes in your boxed set of Offertory envelopes with cash or cheques (payable to Sharing God's Gifts).

Or you can use the Sharing God's Gifts envelope (available at the church entrances) which can be returned via the collection basket as soon as possible. In addition to cash or cheques using this envelope you can make monthly donations with visa, mastercard and pre-authorized debit. Please return through the collection basket or to the parish office to be sure St. Joseph's Parish is credited with your donation – do not mail to the Archdiocese.

I hope, in the spirit of stewardship, you will consider the needs addressed by the Appeal, and join me in supporting the 2024 campaign with a gift to reach our target. As in previous years, if a parish exceeds its appeal goal, the excess amount will be refunded to the parish.
