## SACRED TRIDUUM

Triduum, or the three days, is a three day season beginning at sunset on Holy Thursday and ending at sunset Easter Sunday. During these days we keep one festival - our Passover, our Easter. We join with all people of our Parish - and in spirit with all Christians in every time and place - to fast, pray and keep watch. It is the Passover of the Lord.

**HOLY THURSDAY: 7:00 P.M. - Solemn Remembrance of Jesus' Last Supper**

**GOOD FRIDAY: 3:00 P.M. - Solemn Liturgy of the Lord's Passion and Death.**

### Good Friday is the day of fasting and abstinence.

**Fasting** means eating only one full meal and two smaller meals which means we should experience some degree of hunger (eating between meals is prohibited).

**Abstinence** means abstaining from meat and alcohol. The law of abstinence binds all persons who have completed their 14th year of age. Those persons who have completed their 18th year of age are bound by the law of fasting until they have completed their 59th year of age.

*Parents are reminded of their duty to introduce children to the understanding and importance of penance. Adult's examples will be the greatest influence in this matter.*

**HOLY SATURDAY: 7:00 P.M. – Solemn Easter Vigil Celebration**

### Easter baskets

At the end of our celebration on Holy Saturday there will be blessing of food, which we will eat for Easter breakfast. (Pascha – Risen Christ, Babka - Blessed Mother, Beets - Stain of sin, Cream cheese - Purity and goodness, Butter - Burial ointment, Pysanky - Resurrection, Horseradish - Suffering, Salt – God's grace, Meat - Joyful celebration, Vinegar – Gall, Chocolate bunnies - Symbolizes modern times.

## Divine Mercy

I encourage you to prepare yourself for the Feast of Divine Mercy, which we will celebrate on April 11<sup>th</sup>. The Lord asks that we prepare for this Feast starting with the novena. Saint Sister Faustina wrote in her Diary: **"The Lord told me to recite this Chaplet for the nine days before the Feast of Mercy. Then He told me: 'By this novena I will grant every possible grace to souls'.** Pamphlets on how to pray the Novena are available in church this weekend.
