Sacrament of Penance: Leave a message at the parish office for Fr. Bo to schedule an appointment.

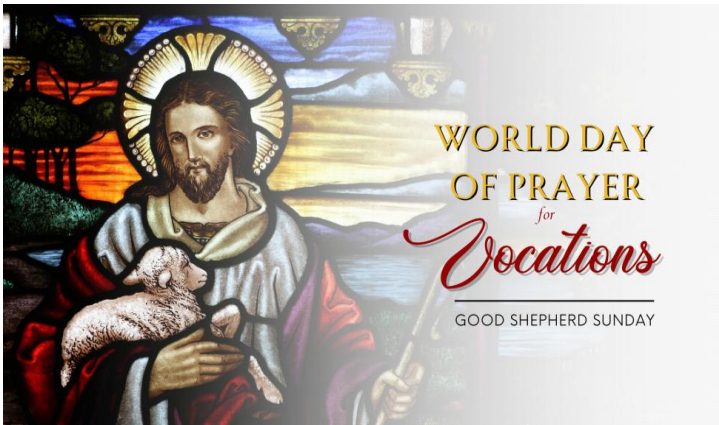
Sacrament of the Sick: by appointment

Registration for Catechism Year 2024-2025

Current students and any siblings who will be starting in Year 1: April 6 to May 18 between 2:00 - 4:30 pm at the Catechism office. Outside these dates & times, by appointment only.

New students: by appointment only - until June 15

Requirements:

- Child's Baptism Certificate
- Parents are registered, contributing members of St Joseph's Parish (Sunday Offering Envelope # or PAC #)

Registration fee \$75/student. Textbook \$35.

Baptisms: You must be a registered member in good standing for a minimum of three months prior to scheduling your child's baptism.

"I have been at St Joseph's Parish for a while but I have never actually registered with the parish. Do I really need to register? What am I missing if I don't?"

Any Catholic and all those who are interested in joining our community are welcome to worship with us without registration. However, there are good reasons to become a registered parishioner in the parish. Anyone requesting baptism for their children or wanting to enroll their children in any of our sacramental programs need to be a registered parishioner in good standing. Couples requesting marriage need to be registered parishioners in good standing.

"Does being registered automatically mean that I am a parishioner in good standing?"

Only those who are formally registered, attend Mass regularly, and accept a financial obligation to the parish appropriate to their means are considered parishioners in good standing. When children of registered families become adult, they should register themselves and begin contributing. For example, that a family is registered does not necessarily mean that their adult children are entitled to be married at St. Joseph's Church.

Think of being registered and in good standing as being a citizen of the country. No matter how long you have been attending, if you are not registered, you are really only a visitor without any of the responsibilities and privileges of a fully enfranchised parishioner. It's a good idea to register and contribute so you can qualify for Parish services.

Pre-Authorized Contributions (PAC)
